HOLI CELEBRATION – 'VtdK ygtthu' RULES & REGULATIONS

- a. **NO VIDEOGRAPHY WILL BE ALLOWED.** Gujarati Samaj is arranging for a professional video service for the entire event.
- b. **All choreographers will submit the participant lists online.** This will help choreographers to manage the participants list at all times. Also, online entry of names will avoid spelling mistakes and automatically verify membership. Please contact Chandrika Patel (248-489-8984) or Jigna Shah (248-427-1861) if you have any questions or problems. Please visit Gujarati Samaj website (www.gsod.org) for additional information and to obtain Holi Celebration Entry Form and Participants List Form.
- c. **Each choreographer can submit maximum of five (5) entries.**
- d. Participants (including Choreographers) or their parents **must** be current members of the Samaj.
- e. A participant **cannot** be in more than one item.
- f. A **maximum** allowable performance time for each item will be **6 minutes**. With prior approval, an additional one (1) minute of stage preparation time will be allowed.
- g. No loose flowers, colored powder, confetti or other similar materials will be allowed on the stage.
- h. No special sound effects, colored lighting, fogging/bubble machine or backdrops will be provided.
- i. One master tape and one backup tape (non-metallic type) for each item or CD must be submitted no later than **Friday, March 23, 2007**. Samaj will not be responsible for poor sound quality due to bad tapes.
- j. Participants will be responsible for their belongings. Samaj will not be responsible for any lost, damaged or stolen articles.
- k. Participants and/or their parents will be responsible for costumes, transportation and rehearsals.
- l. All decisions made by the Executive Committee (EC) will be final. EC reserves the right to reject or deny any item or change the program schedule without prior notice.
- m. The entries will not be limited to dances only. Choreographers are encouraged to be creative. The entries may include a skit, solo performance (singing or playing an instrument), adult-child performances, bhangra, traditional dance, modern dance etc.
- n. **The songs for the dance items will not be repeated.** The choreographers are encouraged to submit their selection as early as possible and must submit the songs to the Holi committee for approval to avoid any song duplication. The song selection will be done on first-come-first-serve basis.
- o. The Holi committee will have rights to limit the number of one type of entry for each group (for example, the committee may decide to limit 2 solo items for each age group)
