



Medicare Medicaid Assistance Program (MMAP) is a free service that can help you make health benefit decisions.

MMAP Volunteer Counselors are trained and certified in Medicare and Medicaid health, benefits and fraud counseling. Counselors are not connected with any insurance company and are not licensed to sell insurance.

A MMAP/SMP counselor can help you:

- Understand Medicare and Medicaid
- Compare or enroll in Medicare Health Plans and Prescription Drug Coverage
- Review Medicare Supplemental Plans
- Understand Medicare Health Plans
- Apply for the Extra Help Program
 - *This program helps with the cost of Medicare Part D*
- Apply for a Medicare Savings Program
 - *This program pays your Medicare premium*
- Review Medicare Summary Notices
- Identify and report Medicare and Medicaid fraud, abuse, and scams with the Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP)
